COMMON REFERRAL TRIGGERS

- Difficulty leaving home for office-based care
- Diabetes or chronic lower-extremity risk
- Painful, thick, or dystrophic nails
- Corns, calluses, or ingrown toenails
- Foot or ankle pain, swelling, or deformity
- Skin breakdown, ulcers, or wounds needing podiatric evaluation

MOBILE PODIATRY SERVICES

- Comprehensive foot and ankle assessment
- Diabetic foot evaluation and education
- Nail and skin care when clinically appropriate
- Wound evaluation and management
- Evaluation of foot and ankle pain
- Care planning for corns, calluses, ingrown toenails, and deformities

A clear handoff keeps the referring team informed

A simple, closed-loop pathway built around role clarity and timely clinical communication.

1

SEND THE REFERRAL

Share patient demographics, the reason for referral, relevant clinical information, and the best contact for coordination.

2

COORDINATE INTAKE

Our team reviews the information and coordinates scheduling with the patient, caregiver, or facility contact.

3

PROVIDE MOBILE CARE

A DPM evaluates and treats the patient at the approved residence or care setting.

4

CLOSE THE LOOP

Visit documentation and recommendations return to the referring team when authorized.

PARTNERSHIP ROLE

Your team retains the primary care relationship.

Illinois Mobile Foot Care provides podiatric specialty care and shares clinical updates with the referring team when authorized.
